Requesting a Form 1095-C (Employer-Provided Health Insurance Offer and Coverage)

In the past, the State Employees' Insurance Board (SEIB) has mailed IRS Form 1095-C, titled Employer-Provided Health Insurance Offer and Coverage, to all employees who were deemed eligible for health insurance based on the regulations of the Affordable Care Act (ACA). Beginning with calendar year 2025, the SEIB is no longer required to mail these forms. However, if you would like a copy of your form, please see the information below.

What is Form 1095-C?

Form 1095-C is a tax form used to report certain information to the IRS and to taxpayers about individuals who are covered by minimum essential health insurance coverage. Employers providing minimum essential health insurance coverage during a calendar year must file the information return reporting the coverage to the IRS and make the form available to the covered person within 30 days of the request.

Your Form 1095-C will be mailed within 30 days of your request to the address the SEIB has on file. You can complete your taxes without the Form 1095-C, as the form is not required for tax filing.

States with Individual Insurance Mandates, such as CA, NJ, RI & DC

Individuals living in states with laws that require reporting of health coverage will continue to receive a paper copy of the Form 1095-C for state tax filing purposes. Individuals filing taxes in one of these states are encouraged to retain a copy of the form for their state tax records.
