Summary of August 18, 2021 Meeting

The State Employees' Insurance Board met at 1:00pm on August 18, 2021 and conducted the following business:

- Approved the May 19, 2021 minutes
- Received a report on the results of the Retiree Position #2 election
- Received a report on the COVID-19 claims experience on the State Employees' Health Insurance Plan.
- Received the Executive Committee Report on its August 9, 2021 meeting, including a review of historical trends, FY2021 Annual Projection vs. Budget, FY2021 Projection and FY2022 Forecast, 2022 Plan Year Benefit Changes, and the 2022 Funding Analysis. The Board voted to approve the following Executive Committee Recommendations for plan year 2022:
 - No Premium Changes
 - Add Residential Treatment Centers, eating disorders only
 - Add Tricare Supplement Plan
 - Add Limited Purpose Health Reimbursement Arrangement
 - Add Retiree Health Reimbursement Arrangement
 - Level State Funding Request for FY2023
 - \$930 per month per each full-time employee
- Received a report on the Healthcare Consulting Services RFP and voted to award contracts to three vendors for Healthcare Consulting Services
- Received a report on the FY2023 agency budget request and the FY2022 annual merit raises for exempt and unclassified non-merit positions and approved the request and annual raises
